**Statutory disclosure and general terms and conditions:** Collective Investment Schemes in Securities (CIS) are generally medium to long term investments. Portfolios are under the STANLIB Collective Investments Scheme (the Scheme). The manager of the Scheme is STANLIB Collective Investments (RF) (PTY) Ltd (the Manager). The Manager is authorised in terms of the Collective Investment Schemes Control Act, No. 45 of 2002 (CISCA) to administer Collective Investment Schemes (CIS) in Securities. Liberty is a full member of the Association for Savings and Investments of South Africa (ASISA). The Manager is a member of the Liberty Group of Companies. The manager has a right to close a portfolio to new investors in order to manage the portfolio more efficiently in accordance with its mandate. A schedule of fees and charges and maximum commissions is available on request to the Manager. The Manager does not provide any guarantee either with respect to the capital or the return of a CIS portfolio. Forward pricing is used. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request. A manager must ensure that performance statistics in an advertisement clearly reflect whether recurring investment or lump sum investment performances are being quoted; whether or not income distributions, prior to deduction of applicable taxes, are included in the calculations.

The trustee of the Scheme is Standard Chartered Bank. The investments of portfolios are managed, on behalf of the Manager, by STANLIB Asset Management (Pty) Ltd, an authorised financial services provider (FSP) under, FSP No. 719, under the Financial Advisory and Intermediary Services Act (FAIS), Act No. 37 of 2002. Prices are calculated and published on each working day, these prices are available on the Manager's website ([www.stanlib.com](http://www.stanlib.com)) and in South African printed news media. Portfolios are valued at 15h00 except Fund of Funds which are valued at 24h00. Forward pricing is used. Investments and repurchases will receive the price of the same day if received prior to 15h00.

All performance returns figures quoted are shown in ZAR and are based on data sourced from Morningstar or Statpro for period ending 31/12/2019. Annualised return figures are the compound annualised growth rate (CAGR) calculated from the cumulative return for the period being measured. These annualised returns provide an indication of the annual return achieved over the period had an investment been held for the entire period.

Portfolio performance figures are calculated for the relevant class of the portfolio, for a lump sum investment, on a NAV-NAV basis, with income reinvested on the ex-dividend date. Individual investor performance may differ due to initial fees, actual investment date, date of reinvestment of income and dividend withholding tax. Investment performance calculations are available for verification upon request. Actual annual figures are available on request.

A Fund of Funds portfolio is a portfolio that invests in other portfolios of collective investment schemes, that levy their own charges, which could result in a higher fee structure for the Fund of Funds portfolio.

A Feeder Fund portfolio is a portfolio that invests in a single portfolio of a collective investment scheme, that levies its own charges, which could result in a higher fee structure for the Feeder Fund.
